


Basics of Religious Knowledge

- 1. Name the religion brought by the Holy Prophet (sa): Islam
- 2. When and where was the Holy Prophet (sa) born?: Makkah in the year 570 A.D
- 3. What does A.D stand for?: This term stands for the Latin word "Anno Domini," which means "The year of our Lord." It refers to the number of years since the birth of Prophet Jesus.
- 4. What was the name of the Holy Prophet's (sa) father?: Hazrat Abdullah (ra).
- 5. What was the name of the Holy Prophet's (sa) mother?: Hazrat Aminah (ra).
- 6. When did the Holy Prophet's (sa) father pass away?: Before Holy Prophet (sa) was born.
- 7. How old was the Holy Prophet (sa) when his mother passed away?:
 He was six years old when his mother passed away.
- 8. Who took care of him after his mother passed away?: His grandfather Hazrat Abdul Muttalib (ra) took care of him.
- 9. How old was the Holy Prophet (sa) when his grandfather Hazrat Abdul-Muttalid (ra) passed away?: He was eight years old.
- 10. Who took care of the Holy Prophet (sa) after his grandfather passed away?: His uncle Hazrat Abu Talid (ra) took care of him.
- 11. What was the name of the nurse who looked after the Holy Prophet (sa)?: Hazrat Halimah (ra)
- 12. To which tribe did the Holy Prophet (sa) belong?: He belonged to the tribe of Quraish



Question and Answer

Topic: Learn Etiquettes of Home 1-10, 11-20

- 1. Ensure that in your home peace and tranquility prevails.
- 2. Your dealings with your parents and other residents of the house should be of a high order. Your relationship should be one of love and attention.
- 3. Be especially kind and considerate towards parents.
- 4. Proper etiquette should be observed at all times. Avoid mistrust and suspicion of others. Younger members of the family should obey their seniors and the seniors should treat the younger ones with extreme kindness. Your treatment of friends and acquaintances or other members of the household should also be of a high order.
- 5. Make a habit of using the following terms while in the house: Assalamu Alaikum, Jazakumullah, Masha'Allah, Bismillah, Alhamdullilah, InshaAllah.
- 6. The house should always be neat and clean.
- 7. Make a habit of retiring early and getting up early.
- 8. Make a habit of reciting a portion of the Holy Quran every morning.
- 9. Apart from congregational prayers in a mosque, make it a habit to offer Sunnah and Nawafil at home. Those who cannot get to the mosque should make adequate arrangements to offer salat at home at the appropriate times. The responsible seniors should, as far as possible, encourage those who are able, to go to the mosque for offering congregational prayers.
- 10. It was a sunnah of the Holy Prophet (sa) to perform ablution before going to bed.
